Sportfloor Grip & Clean is a specific solution for sports floors; it easily removes dust, dirt and halos and allows to obtain a surface with an optimal grip for game shoes. It is used both to prepare the surface before a game and to renew and improve the grip of the shoes during the game.

How to use

As a playing field preparer – Pour two caps of Sportfloor Grip & Clean into 5 liters of water. With this solution, wash the entire surface using a well-wrung damp cloth. It is not necessary to rinse. In case of more intense dirt, wash using a sponge soaked in pure Sportfloor Grip & Clean; alternatively use Sportfloor Cleaner. Avoid excess or stagnation of product on the floor which could lead to an increase in slipperiness.

As a shoe preparer – Pour pure Sportfloor Grip & Clean on a towel and use it to clean the sole of players' shoes periodically during the game.

Dirty Sportfloor Grip & Clean cloths can be washed simply by rinsing them with clean water.

Notes

Shake before use.

Do not exceed the recommended ratio for dilution and do not exceed the quantity of product applied.
